Racers and Spectators enjoy a course which affords constant action at the hub of Northstar's mid-mountain activities, with racers crossing the S/F multiple times. 5K Start/Finish at Northstar® Resort Cross-Country Center, a constant rolling course incorporating groomed and un-groomed single-track sections, an adventurous challenge for fitness and orienteering skills. 10K Start/Finish at Northstar Cross-Country Center incorporates two loops of the 5K course. Kid's Rising Star Rumble is a 500 meter-1K course on groomed and un-groomed trails.
